*Riders compete one at a time, working through a series of 8 obstacles. If an Entry fails to completely negotiate an obstacle within one minute, only partial points will be awarded. Failure to BEGIN to negotiate an obstacle within 30 seconds of arrival at the obstacle, or 3 refusals, regardless of the length of time, will result in a score of zero for that obstacle. A score of Zero to 10 point will be given for each obstacle. A score of 5 indicates an average job. In the case of a tie the contestants will be asked to work through another series of obstacles or work in the ring on the flat.*

### RING I - START TIME 9AM

1. *Fitting and Showmanship Class - Open to English & Western- 50 Points: Appearance of Equine(condition, grooming, turnout) 50 points : Showing of the Equine (Trotting/Jogging, standing/posing, soundness) Specs will be posted.*
2. *English Pleasure – wtc-To be judged on the horse’s way of going, and the ability to give a pleasurable ride. Suitability of rider and horse to count. May be asked to halt or back.*
3. *Western Pleasure - W, J, L, -The same description as Class #2.*
4. *Open Pleasure- Western horses to Jog and Lope. English Horses to trot and Canter.*
5. *Command Class – Western & English – Riders are eliminated for failure to obey the judge’s commands.*
6. *Pair Class – Color counts 10% - English & Western – WTC/WJL –Ability to stay in rhythm together at all gaits.*
7. *English Equitation – To be judged on Rider’s position and control of the horse.*
8. *Western Equitation – to be judged on Rider’s position and control of the horse.*
9. *Hunter Hack – Will be asked to Hand Gallop, Halt, & Jump a cross rail.*
10. *Schooling Hunter over Fences – Heights set at 2’ and 2’6” –*
11. *Schooling Hunter over Fences – the same as Class #10*
12. *Schooling Handy Hunter over Fences – Heights set at 2’ and 2’6” - a course that simulates jumping in the Hunt Field, roll back turns, trot fence, halt*
