1. JUNIOR ENGLISH PLEASURE– W/T/C – To be judged on the horses’ way of going, and the ability to give a pleasurable ride. Suitability of horse & rider to count. May be asked to halt and back.
2. ADULT ENGLISH PLEASURE – The same as Class #1
3. OPEN PLEASURE- WTC may be asked to hand gallop or extend the trot. Will be asked to Halt and Back.
4. BRIDLE PATH HACK – Riders will be asked to hand gallop, halt, back, and jump 1 small fence.
5. MAIDEN EQUITATION ON THE FLAT– Judged on the rider’s position & control of the horse. For riders who have not won a 1st place ribbon in an Equitation Class.
6. NOVICE ENGLISH EQUITATION ON THE FLAT - Same as class #6 - May not have won 6 Blue Ribbons.
7. SCHOOLING HUNTER UNDER SADDLE – 2’ division
8. NOVICE CHILDREN/ADULT UNDER SADDLE

SCHOOLING BREAK –No more than 5 in the ring at a time for 7 minutes each group
