JUDGING

Hunter Classes

Judged on performance, soundness, suitability, and manners.

Equitation Classes

Riders should have a workmanlike appearance with correct position. Seat & hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control should any emergency arise.

Jumper Classes

The winner of a jumper class is the horse and rider combination to finish a course with the least amount of rails dropped, combined with completing the course the fastest.

Schooling over Fences Fee: \$10 (Ring II & Jumpers - no charge)
Hunters & Equitation: \$15 per class
Jumpers: \$20 per class

- 7. **LEVEL 1 HUNTER** Fences at 2'3" Open to all riders
- 8. **LEVEL 1 HUNTER** Fences at 2'3" Open to all riders
- 9. LEVEL 1 HANDY HUNTER Fences at 2'3" Open to all riders
- 10. SCHOOLING HUNTER UNDER SADDLE Open to all riders
- 11. LEVEL 1 HUNTER UNDER SADDLE Open to all riders
- 12. **MAIDEN EQUITATION ON THE FLAT** Judged on the rider's position & control of the horse. Open to riders who have never won a 1st place ribbon in an Equitation Class.
- 13. **NOVICE EQUITATION ON THE FLAT** For riders who have not won three 1st place ribbons over fences in Equitation Classes.
- 14. **BARBARA ROGERS BRIDLE PATH HACK** Riders will be asked to halt, hand gallop, and jump a small jump individually- open to to all riders

- SCHOOLING BREAK -No more than 5 in the ring at a time, 10 minutes

- 15. WARM-UP CLASS 2'6" & 3'- Open to all horses & ponies. (Open card, classes 15-28)
- 16. **LOW HUNTER-** Fences at 2'6"- Open to all riders
- 17. **LOW HUNTER** Fences at 2'6"- Open to all riders

- 25. **MINI MACLAY** Flat Phase goes first. All riders to come back for Jumping Phase- Fences at 2'6
- 26. MINI MEDAL Fences at 2'6" Top 4 riders will be called back to be tested.
- 27. **SUSAN LOWE MEMORIAL HANDY HUNTER CLASSIC** Fences at 2'6" or 3' This class will test the skills that riders and their horses might use during an enjoyable day of foxhunting, which Sue loved. Riders may be asked to hand gallop, counter canter, trot a fence, and open/close a gate while mounted.
