2. ADULT ENGLISH PLEASURE – The same as Class #1
3. OPEN PLEASURE- WTC may be asked to hand gallop or extend the trot. Will be asked to Halt and Back.
4. MAIDEN EQUITATION ON THE FLAT– Judged on the rider’s position & control of the horse. For riders who have not won A 1st place ribbons in an Equitation Class.
5. NOVICE ENGLISH EQUITATION ON THE FLAT - Same as class #6 - May not have won 6 Blue Ribbons.
6. NOVICE CHILDREN/ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE.
7. BRIDLE PATH HACK – Riders will be asked to hand gallop, back, and jump 1 small fence.
8. MAIDEN EQUITATION OVER FENCES – Fences at 2’ - Riders who have not won 1 Blue Ribbon in Equitation over fences.
