Jump Start Horse Show Hosted by Bridle Path Manor

1. Each horse/rider combination receives a separate number.
2. Classes are \$20 each, except M&S classes, which are \$35 each. All entries showing over fences will be charged a schooling fee of \$15. Crossrail entries will be charged a schooling fee of \$5. Office/Ins./EMT fee is \$25.
3. Full payment or an open check must be left with the secretary before a number will be issued. There will be a \$100.00 surcharge for all checks returned by the bank. Refunds are available for scratched classes if the scratch is made before the class begins.
4. Secretary must have current negative Coggins test results and proof of rabies vaccination before a number will be issued.
5. While on show grounds, all mounted riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets. No stallions may be brought to this show.
6. If Only Farm and Bridle Path Manor will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage to any person, equine, or property.
7. Very limited stabling is available. The charge is \$55.00. Stabling reservations should be made in advance with show manager Kathy Zimmer – 315-727-5391.
8. Show management reserves the right to change, divide, cancel, or combine classes.
9. Prizes and ribbons for Champion and Reserve will be awarded for each division in which 4 or more entries compete. Champion and Reserve ribbons only will be awarded in divisions with 3 or fewer entries. Points are accumulated on horse/rider combinations.
10. No dogs allowed.
11. Each horse/rider combination may participate in one warm-up class. This is a judged class, run on an open card. Rider should notify starter when riding a warm-up trip.
12. To accumulate points towards the Marshall & Sterling Finals, riders must be members of the Marshall & Sterling League. Membership forms are available at the secretary's desk.

DIVISIONS

Schooling Hunter: Open to all horses and riders.

Limit Rider: Open to riders who have not won 6 classes at 2'3".

Low Hunter: Open to all horses and riders.

Child/Adult Hunter: Open to non-professional riders of any age.

Novice Rider: Riders may not enter any other classes over fences, but may enter flat classes for which they are otherwise eligible.

Walk/Trot: Open to riders of any age. Riders may not cross enter to any other divisions.

Short/Long Stirrup: Open to riders of any age. Riders will be asked to canter. Riders may not cross enter to any other division.
